9. **Arcadia Coco Loco Choc Stout:** (Foreign Extra Stout) Arcadia refers to it as their “triple choc milk stout”.

10. **Arcadia Hop Mouth Double IPA:** (Imperial IPA) Pronounced hop bitterness times 2!

11. **Arcadia IPA:** (English IPA) Pronounced hop bitterness/balanced by med-bodied, lightly caramel & toasted malt character.

390. **Arcadia Imperial Stout:** (Russian Imperial Stout) Excellent example of the style.

12. **Arcadia London Porter:** Subtle smoky flavor from beech wood smoked malt & lingering hoppy bitterness.

388. **Arcadia Skyhigh Rye:** Nice hoppy kick without excessive bitterness. Very nice!

82. **Dirty Blond:** (Witbier) Coriander & lemon aroma. Nice, easy to drink wheat beer.

15. **Atwater Vanilla Java Porter:** Award winner made with chocolate malt & brewed with coffee beans.

362. **Voodoo Vator Doppelbock:** Black & sweet. A smooth high gravity brewski. 9.5% alc

29. **Bell's Amber Ale:** (American Amber) This is Bell's flagship beer.

30. **Bell's Batch 9000:** (Imperial IPA) Black, dense and rich! 12.5 % Alc.

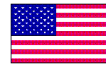

138. **He'Brew Origin Pomegranate** (Shmaltz/San Francisco/**Fruit-Amer Amber**) Smooth, sweet malt flavor w/ moderate hop bitterness.
141. **Hennepin Farmhouse** (Ommegang/New York/**Saison**) Refreshing with nice complexity. Hides the Alc. well. 7.7% Alc
148. **Hop Devil** (Victory/Pennsylvania/**American IPA**) Tastes really hoppy with interesting aftertaste. Try it. 6.7% Alc
149. **Hop Stoopid** (Lagunitas/California/**Imperial IPA**) Nice taste with huge malt & hop presence. 8% Alc
150. **Hop Wallop** (Victory/Pennsylvania/**Imperial IPA**) Very drinkable for an 8.5% Alc. Packs a hop wallop!

322. **Southern Tier IPA** (South. Tier/New York/**American IPA**) Very drinkable. More emphasis on hops than many others. 6.9% Alc
323. **Southern Tier Raspberry Wheat** (South. Tier/New York/**Fruit-American Pale**) Light berry flavor, slightly tart, dry.
358. **Southern Tier Un Earthly** (South. Tier/New York/**Imperial IPA**) A Big beer! Assertive hoppy flavor. 9.8% Alc
324. **Spanish Peaks Honey Raspberry Ale** (Spanish Peaks/Montana/**Fruit**) Fruity amber ale with soft palate & touch of sweetness.
329. **Stone Old Guardian Barley** (Stone/San Diego/**American Barleywine**) Limited supply-no longer brewed. A Big beer! 11.26% Alc
330. **Stone Pale Ale** (Stone/San Diego/**American Pale**) Stone's flagship ale is robust and full flavored. Worth trying.
331. **Stone IPA** (Stone/San Diego/**American IPA**) Very Bitter (pine?). Light malts in background. 6.9% Alc
332. **Stoudt's Double IPA** (Stoudts/Pennsylvania/**Imperial IPA**) Taste is sweet with intense hop completion. 10% alc
333. **Stoudt's Fat Dog** (Stoudts/Pennsylvania/**Russian Imperial Stout**) Fusion of Oatmeal Stout & Imperial Stout. 9% alc
334. **Stoudt's Scarlet Lady** (Stoudts/Pennsylvania/**Extra Special/Strong Bitter**) Somewhat complex with substantial body.
337. **Summit Extra Pale** (Summit/Minnesota/**Extra Special Bitter**) Pronounced hop/bitter flavor & a light bronze color.
339. **Sword Swallower, Coney Island** (Shmaltz/New York/**Classic American Pils**) Nicely balanced. Hops add interest!
346. **Three Philosophers** (Ommegang/New York/**Belgian Dark Strong**) Combines Belgian ale with Lindemans Kriek. 9.8% alc.

347. **Thirsty Dog Raspberry** (Thirsty Dog/Ohio/**Fruit**) Sweet ⁴ raspberry flavor. Good carbonation. Hints of hops at finish.
348. **Torpedo IPA** (Sierra Nevada/California/**Imperial IPA**) Bold, assertive & full of flavor. Goes down smooth. 7.2% Alc
352. **Trout Slayer** (Big Sky/Montana/**American Wheat**) Refreshing & smooth session wheat brew!
355. **Turbodog** (Abita/Louisiana/**American Brown**) Faint malt up front. Smooth. Slightly bitter. Good brew.
359. **U.S. Pale Ale** (Capital/Wisconsin/**American Pale**) Easy to drink. Good session beer.
358. **Unearthly IPA** (South. Tier/New York/**Imperial IPA**) Creamy with nice hop bite & hoppy finish. 10% Alc
361. **Vanilla Porter** (Breckenridge/Denver/**Porter**) Smooth roasted chocolate flavor with a vanilla finish. Very nice.
372. **Widmer Hef** (Widmer/Oregon/**American Wheat**) An unfiltered, suspended yeast, wheat beer. Excellent!
375. **Woodchuck Granny Smith** (Green Mt/Vermont/**Cider**). Alcoholic cider from granny smith apples with a touch of sweetness.

379. **Zipfer** (Brau Union/**Doppelbock**) Rich, clean & refreshing.

67. **Coopers Sparkling** (Coopers/**Standard/Ordinary Bitter**) Biting sharpness with citrus & hop notes.
109. **Foster’s Lager** (Foster’s/**Standard American**) Light malt aroma, well hopped flavor. 25 oz “oil can”.

4. **Affligem Blond** (Affligem/**Belgian Blond**) From Belgium’s oldest brewery (1129). Hoppy with dense, creamy head. 7% alc.

41. **Blanche de bruxelles** (Lefebvre/**Witbier**) Refreshing wheat with mid/high carbonation & pleasing sweet/sour taste.

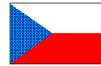

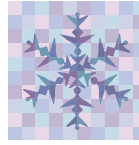
